FEES, CHARGES AND COURSES

The membership year is from 1 April and no discount / rebate may be taken for any reason. The subscription is an annual fee irrespective of method of payment.

Members who join during the membership year are entitled to pro rata rates. All new members must sign a direct debit to cover all their membership and flying charges.

All flying members (Full, Honorary, Cadet/Junior and Student) are required to pay the BGA Capitation fee in addition to their membership in April or upon joining. This is currently set at £26. Members who obtain written confirmation, from either the BGA or another club that their capitation fee is being paid by another club may have this fee credited to their flying account.

The 6 or 12 month DD plan is offered to all members but existing members who pay quarterly by DD (not cheque or credit card) may continue to do so at £162 per quarter.

All facilities fees are for one full year commencing on 1 January. As places are limited they are offered by arrangement with the committee and CFI only. No refunds are available. VAT at current rates will be added to all prices when invoiced to any form of company.

Notes:

Up to 30 minutes free soaring before 11:00 and for flights commencing after 1730.

Gliders on expeditions are charged for all soaring hours, with no maximum.

MOTOR GLIDER

£90 per Hobbs hour irrespective of engine time.

Purchasers of courses may exchange tow height for time in the motor glider.

TUG FLYING

£140 per hour subject to insurance restrictions and only by arrangement with the Tug Master.
