## MEMBERSHIP FEES APRIL 2017 – MARCH 2018

Junior	Under 26 on 1/4/17	£374	DD option: £43.50pm for 9 months, flying fees also to be paid by DD
Associate	Non gliding member	£82.50	
Temporary	Full member of BGA club (max 7 days in membership year)	£13.50 / day or £66 / week (+ VAT)	

The membership year is from 1 April and no discount / rebate may be taken for any reason. The subscription is an annual fee irrespective of method of payment.

Members who join during the membership year are entitled to pro rata rates. All new members must sign a direct debit to cover all their membership and flying charges.

All flying members (Full, Honorary, Cadet / Junior and Student) are required to pay the BGA Capitation fee in addition to their membership in April or upon joining. This is currently set at £30. Members who obtain written confirmation from either the BGA or another club that their capitation fee is being paid by another club may have this fee credited to their flying account.

The quarterly DD scheme has been withdrawn.

Booker Gliding Club is a Community Amateur Sports Club and fully supports participation in gliding by all in the community. If you want to participate in gliding activities with us, but are worried about the cost, please contact the Club Secretary to discuss the options in confidence.

Glider kept in the trailer park, in or out of trailer	£372 per year
Second (empty) trailer	£197 per year
Glider brought onto site on or after 1 August	£212 to end of December
Visiting gliders (except competitions)	£10 per day (max 7 days in one year) + VAT
SLMGs kept in trailers or standing in the trailer park	£1,195 per year
Hangar space for powered aircraft	£3,090 per year
Wintering trailer in hangar	£85 per month (min 4 months)
Glider in trailer kept temporarily in trailer park (1 Jan to 31 March only)	£16 a week (max 13 weeks)

All facilities fees are for one full year commencing on 1 January. As places are limited they are offered by arrangement with the committee and CFI only. No refunds are available. VAT at current rates will be added to all prices when invoiced to any form of company.

## **LAUNCH FEES FROM 1 JANUARY 2016**

Launch fees are calculated at £12.50 + £1.20 per 100ft subject to a minimum of £24.50.

Ridge tow (not more than 1500ft in gliding reach of ridge)	£36.50
High tow to 4000ft	£55.50
Special price aerobatic tow to 4000ft	£49.50
Circuit practice and cable breaks (max 1000ft) for ab-initios	£21.00

Aero-tow retrieve at £3.60 / nm from Booker subject to a minimum of £35.00

*Note: If the tug does not land because the field is unsuitable the full charge is payable.*
