

AIRSPACE

You will know that we are having problems with Heathrow Traffic in our local airspace.

Provisional agreement has been reached with C.A.A. for a new airspace pattern in our area which will permit us to continue to operate with certain restrictions. Although this cannot be introduced until the winter of 1973, we intend to operate as from now, the locally imposed restriction.

When Heathrow aircraft are landing in an easterly direction, gliders will not be permitted to fly above 2,500' QNH (2,000' above Wycombe Air Park on a QFE) east of a line Beacon Hill, Lane End (western edge), Henley, Reading.

It is in your own interests to observe this rule
